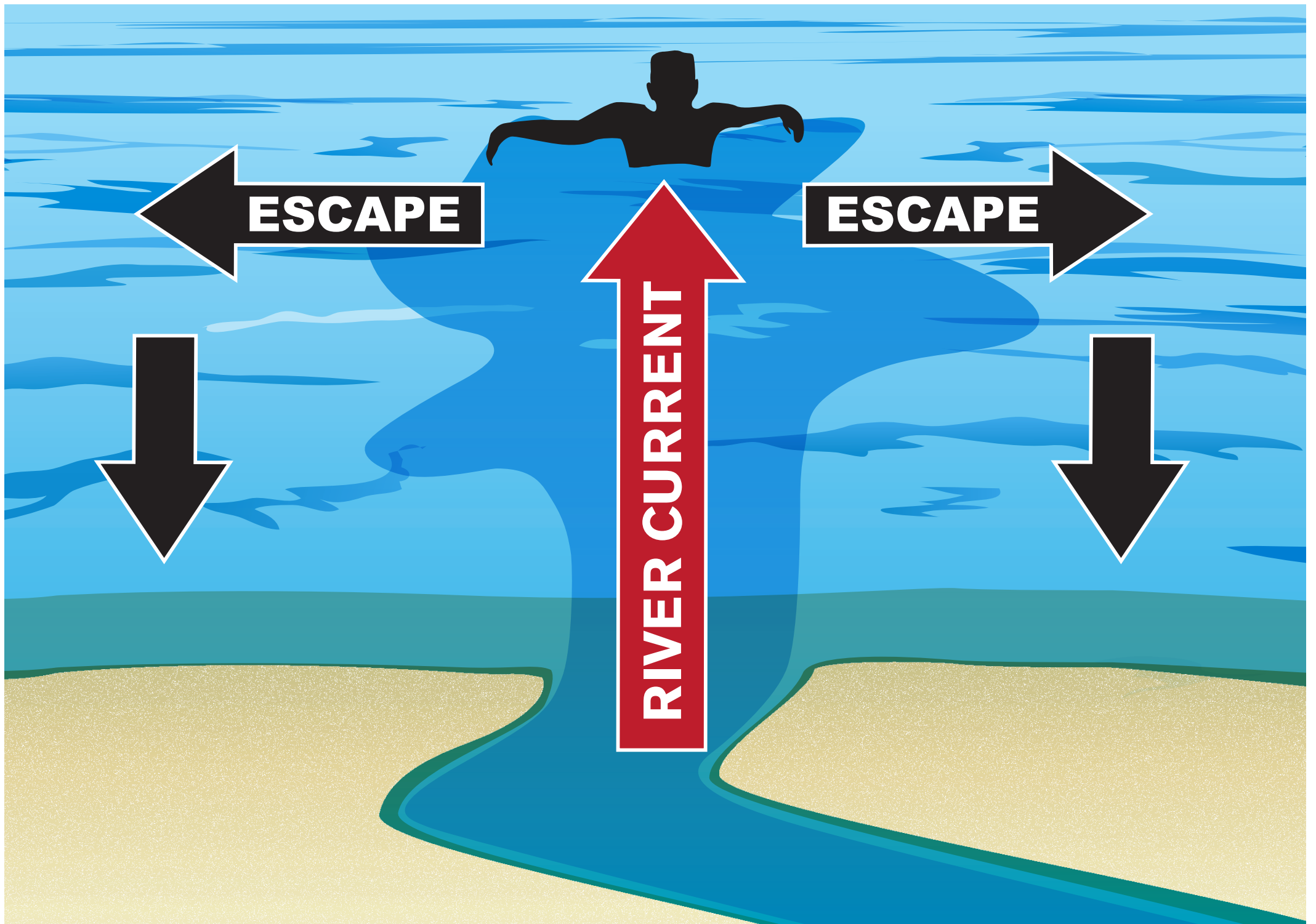


Dangerous Current
